Election

General election:

We had a large turnout of 823 in-person, 523 absent voter, and 122 voters went to an early voting site to cast their ballot. Two permanent absentee lists are in effect today.

Permanent Absentee Application List- voters receive an application to vote absentee.

Permanent Ballot List -to automatically receive a ballot.

Early Voting sites will be available for all federal & state elections 9 consecutive days prior to the Election. Currently there are 4 sites in Kalamazoo County. And of course, you may still get an absentee ballot at the township hall, and vote in-person election day.

TREASURER:This newsletter will arrive with your wanter tax bills that are due by February 14^{th, 2025} We send tax bills to everyone even if you have them paid by your mortgage company. Look on the upper left corner of the tax stub at the bottom third of the tax bill where it says "Mortgage Co." if there is a company printed there they are asking for the tax bill to process payment. We send the tax bill to you so you know how much your taxes are that the mortgage company is paying.

Payments received after February 14, 2025 will have a 1% interest per month and a 3% penalty added. To get correct amount owed, please call Township Treasurer's office.
